

## Board Minutes Monday March 28, 2011

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment with all members present.

Lee Bjerke, county Engineer, met with the Board to discuss road matters.

Tom and Tara, Bushman Insurance, met with the Board to discuss the ICAP renewal for FY12.

Moved by Bouska and seconded by Pierce to approve the Class C with outdoor and Sunday sales liquor license for Silvercrest Golf & Country Club and the Class C with Sunday sales Beer Permit for Sattre Store. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board met with the Department Heads to discuss the proposed changes in the employee manual and department updates.

Moved by Bouska and seconded by Logsdon to approve the claims filed with the Board. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Ibanez and seconded by Logsdon to approve the minutes for the Monday March 21, 2010 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Leon Bohr, county Sheriff, met with the Board to discuss the work hours for the Sheriff's Civil Clerks. The Board verified that the Sheriff's Civil Clerks were required to work forty (40) hours per week with no paid lunch time.

Andy Van Der Maaten, county Attorney, met with the Board to discuss county matters.

Krista Vandenbrink, county Public Health, and several other public health nurses met with the Board to witness the National Public Health Week proclamation. Moved by Logsdon and seconded by Pierce to proclaim April 4 – 10 National Public Health Week in Winneshiek County. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Bouska and seconded by Pierce to send a letter to Senator Mary Jo Wilhelm and Representatives Brian Quirk and Bob Hager to reiterate the need for more road use tax funding for county roads. Motion carried unanimously.

Julie Fischer, Deb Bishop, and Janelle Pavlovec; the Caretaker's House Coalition, met with the Board to make another plea for further consideration before the demolition of the house at the county farm. Moved by Ibanez and seconded by Pierce to rescind the action taken at the March 21, 2010 meeting to

provide additional time for a community based group to find a viable alternative to deconstruction of the house at the county farm. Motion failed with Ibanez and Pierce voting aye; and Logsdon, Bouska and Askelson voting nay.

Moved by Logsdon and seconded by Pierce to adjourn to 9:30am Monday April 4, 2011. Motion carried unanimously.
