Gergg also talked about doing a prairie grass planting at Crossroads as well. He would want to look at the site but thinks what we're describing would work well for a prairie grass planting.

Janelle moves to let Gregg make us a plan for Plymouth Rock and move ahead with that project and while he's at it we'll have him look at the potential Crossroads project, Jody 2nd – Passes unanimously.
