Agent Orange Exposure Locations

- **Between January 9, 1962, and May 7, 1975, you must have served for any length of time in at least one of these locations:** In the Republic of Vietnam, or aboard a U.S. military vessel that operated in the inland waterways of Vietnam, or on a vessel operating not more than 12 nautical miles seaward from the demarcation line of the waters of Vietnam and Cambodia.
You served in or near the **Korean DMZ** for any length of time between September 1, 1967, and August 31, 1971
- **Thailand**—At any United States or Royal Thai base during the period beginning on **January 9, 1962, and ending on June 30, 1976**, without regard to where on the base the veteran was located or what military job specialty the veteran performed.
- **Laos**—During the period beginning on **December 1, 1965, and ending on September 30, 1969**.
- **Cambodia**—At Mimot or Krek, Kampong Cham Province during the period beginning on April 16, 1969, and ending on April 30, 1969.
- **Guam or American Samoa**, or in the territorial waters thereof, during the period beginning on **January 9, 1962, and ending on July 31, 1980**
- **Johnston Atoll**—Served on Johnston Atoll or on a ship that called at Johnston Atoll during the period beginning on **January 1, 1972, and ending on September 30, 1977**.
- You served on active duty in a regular Air Force unit location where a **C-123 aircraft** with traces of Agent Orange was assigned, and had repeated contact with this aircraft due to your flight, ground, or medical duties.
- You were **involved in transporting, testing, storing, or other uses of Agent Orange** during your military service
- You were assigned as a Reservist to certain flight, ground, or medical crew duties at one of the below locations:
 - * **Lockbourne/Rickenbacker Air Force Base** in Ohio, 1969 to 1986 (906th and 907th Tactical Air Groups or 355th and 356th Tactical Airlift Squadrons)
 - * **Westover Air Force Base** in Massachusetts, 1972 to 1982 (731st Tactical Air Squadron and 74th Aeromedical

Burn Pit / Toxic Exposure Locations

Presumptive diseases based on burn pits and toxic exposures for those who served: **on or after August 2, 1990**, performed active military, naval, air, or space service while assigned to a duty station in, including airspace above:
Bahrain; Iraq; Kuwait; Oman; Qatar; Saudi Arabia; Somalia; United Arab Emirates.

Presumptive diseases based on burn pits and toxic exposures for those who served: **on or after September 11, 2001**, performed active military, naval, air, or space service while assigned to a duty station in, including airspace above:
Afghanistan; Djibouti; Egypt; Jordan; Lebanon; Syria; Yemen; Uzbekistan;
or any other country determined relevant by the Secretary.
