

Board Minutes November 27, 2023

The Board of Supervisors met at 9:30am November 27, 2023 with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited, and the meeting was called to order.

The Board discussed the property in Freeport that Iowa Rotocast Plastics requested the Board consider selling. They have an appraisal for the property and will work with the County Attorney to set up a public hearing and bidding procedure.

Moved by Kelsay and seconded by Faldet to approve the Notice to Proceed for the Festina Sewer Project. Motion carried unanimously.

Barb Schroeder, Conservation Director, met with the Board to discuss the Statewide Transportation Alternatives Grant program. Due to lack of matching funds and time constraints the Board will not participate in this funding opportunity.

Andy Van Der Maaten, County Attorney, met with the Board to discuss county issues.

Moved by Vick and seconded by Vermace to approve the consent agenda which includes the minutes of the last meeting and the claims filed with the Board. Motion carried unanimously.

Nick Rissman, Interim County Engineer, met with the Board to discuss road matters. He reported there were not grants specific to replacing the radar speed signs. The consensus of the Board was to replace the malfunctioning ones out of the budget for signage, but to research vendors to be sure to purchase a quality product for the best price.
